Proposed data centre at Cardiff East Park and Ride
Before this development is approved, every resident deserves to understand what is being proposed and how it could affect our community.

What the planning application proposes?

According to the applicant's planning documents, the proposed development includes, a large scale data centre at the Cardiff East Park and Ride site. a temporary on-site energy centre while awaiting a permanent electricity connection, temporary gas powered generation together with standby diesel generators during that period, a facility designed to operate continuously, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, new infrastructure associated with the development, including works close to the River Rhymney, and environmental mitigation measures covering ecology, air quality, noise and landscaping.

Noise pollution

How will continuous operation and temporary on-site power generation affect nearby homes?

Gas-powered generation

What effect could temporary gas-powered generation have on local air quality? And how will emissions be monitored? Wildlife and the river Rhymney. How will habitats be protected?

Water

The planning documents assess significant water demand. Residents may wish to ask, how much water will be required and what impact could this have on local resources

Wild life and the Environment

The true impact on local wild life in the and around the river is of major concern to everyone in the area. The continuous background noise pollution will decrease bird and insect habitats.

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Why this matters...

This proposal represents a significant change to Llanrumney. Residents may wish to consider environmental impacts, operational noise, air quality, effects on wildlife, water demand, construction disruption, visual impact, long-term changes to the area. These are important issues that deserve careful public scrutiny before any planning decision is made.
